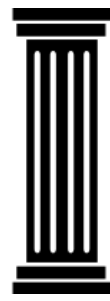

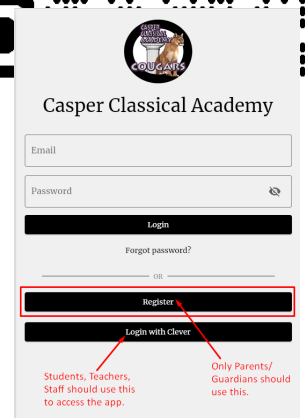
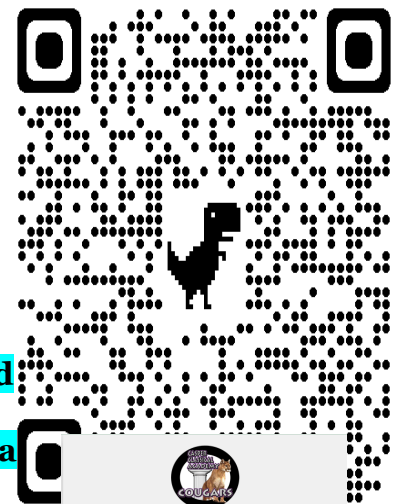

Middle Level Temporary Virtual Day IF there is ever a need

Purpose: We know that being “on” synchronously for an entire day can be very tiring for both students and teachers. Our proposal is intended to maximize their time on the computers with half of a period being synchronous, and a little time after for questions as needed. At the end of the day, there will be a period of time that is called Office Hours, intended for students to reach out to teachers as needed for assistance on the day’s lesson, or other needs.

Students will be on virtually with each teacher for 22 minutes, with a 5 minute time period after in case there are questions, followed by a 3 minute “passing period”. From 12:30-2:48 pm, all teachers will be available to answer any questions or give assistance to students during “Office Hours”.

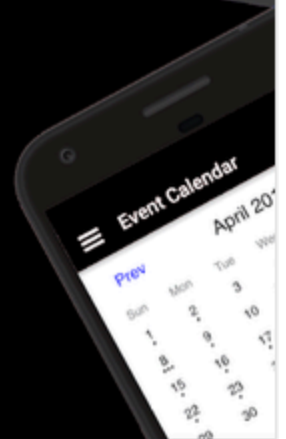
